### LEVEL C RANKING EVENT

Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> MARCH 2017

**EVENT CENTRE** and Registration near the Octavia bunkhouse signed from the end of Piper's Green Road, off Chart Lane, Ide Hill, Sevenoaks, Kent. Nearest postcode TN16 1ND.  
Grid Reference TQ46346 52896.

Parking will be in an open field, £1 parking charge per car. Portaloos provided, no other facilities.

**Public Transport:**

There is no readily accessible public transport option. Nearest rail station at Sevenoaks. There is a number 246 bus hourly from Bromley to Westerham via Bromley South and Hayes stations. Also an hourly bus 401 from Sevenoaks Rail Station to Brasted and Westerham. Then a long walk from either Brasted (2.2km), or Westerham (3km).

Brasted Chart is owned by the National Trust and DFOK is grateful for permission to hold this event.

**REGISTRATION:** Pre entry by Fabian4. EOD registration 10:00am, starts 10:30 to 12:30, courses close 14.30.

SI electronic punching will be used. Dibber Hire £1. Hire EOD or collect prepaid from Registration.

**DOGS:** Only on a lead please.

**COURTESY TO OTHERS:** The area has several bridleways and is well used by horse riders, walkers and dog lovers. Please be considerate to other users. There are a few private houses in the area which are marked as OOB. Please avoid these areas.

**START AND FINISH:** One start for all courses. Courses close at 14:30. Start is approx 400m from Registration. Finish 100m from registration. No clothing dump. Pre-entries can go straight to the start.

**ROAD CROSSING:** Courses Green, Blue and Brown cross a minor road. This will be marshaled and timed out. Participants are responsible for their own safety.

**TERRAIN and MAP:** Brasted Chart is part of the Lower Greensand Ridge which runs all the way along the northern side of the Weald of Kent, just to the south of the North Downs. The map covers an area of ancient woodland with an excellent network of paths and ground features. The area was used for SE Relays in 2013 and SE Middle Champs in 2015. 1:7500 scale, overprinted and waterproof. Control descriptions on the map and loose control descriptions in start lanes.

**COURSES:** Distances subject to controlling

Brown (6.7k), Blue (5.4k), Green (4.3k), Lt Green (3.1k), Orange (2.6k), Yellow (2.4k)
