**CHELWOOD VACHERY** (part of ASHDOWN FOREST)

on **SUNDAY 5th FEBRUARY 2012**

**LOCATION:** Chelwood Vachery is part of Ashdown Forest located south of East Grinstead between the A22 & A275. DFOK is grateful to the Conservators of Ashdown Forest for permission to hold this event.

**PARKING:** Parking is at The Ashdown Forest Llama Park <http://www.llamapark.co.uk/> TN22 3HW, OS sheet 187 TQ424314 on the east side of the A22. The event will be signed on the A22 from Wych Cross (junction of A275 & A22) to the North of the Llama Centre. Parking fee of £1 to the Llama Park. Start and finish are close to the assembly area, crossing the A22 (marshalled crossing).

**FACILITIES:** Registration will be adjacent to the car park in one of the buildings at the Llama Park. Toilets will be available. The cafe will be open from 10:00 serving hot and cold drinks. Food will include a choice of two soups, jacket potatoes with a variety of fillings and a hot vegetarian dish. Young children can be entertained in the Ashdown Forest Llama Park. Entry to the Llama Park would normally be £4.50 for adults and £3.50 for children. There is a £1 discount for adult orienteers on production of a BOF membership card.

**REGISTRATION:** Opens at 09:30, starts 10:00 to 12:00, courses close 14.00

**DOGS:** On a lead only please.

**TERRAIN:** Mixed, open moorland with cropped open areas, heather & dead bracken, mainly runnable forest, some marshy areas, good path/ride network.

**COURSES:** White, Yellow, Orange, Lt Green, Green, Short Blue, Blue, Short Brown, Brown.

**MAP:** 1:10,000 surveyed 2009 by Roger Maher with updating by DFOK members during Winter 2010 and Winter 2011

**PUNCHING:** SI electronic punching will be used, dibber hire £1 (£35 if lost).
