



Leybourne & Leybourne Lakes Street / Park Event



17 January 2018

Kent Night Cup

Important Note - Insurance advice from British Orienteering.

*Under 16's may take part in this event individually if they only visit Leybourne Lakes Country Park.
Under 16's may use the whole area non-competitively provided they are accompanied by an adult at all times and the adult assumes full responsibility for them. Note that neither the junior nor the accompanying adult will be eligible for KNC league points.*

Venue :	The streets and paths of Leybourne, plus the parkland around Leybourne Lakes. The streets are mainly lit but there are some unlit paths and roads. Leybourne Lakes Country Park is unlit. A head or hand torch will be necessary.
Map :	1:7,500 scale with 5m contours. Combined street and park map with minor updates.
Directions :	From M20 Junction 4 head north onto the A228 (Castle Way). After 400m turn right at the traffic lights onto Leybourne Way. After about 0.5 mile turn right into Tesco Lunsford Park Supermarket. The nearest train stations are: New Hythe on the Medway Valley Line (1.0 mile) or East Malling on the Victoria to Ashford via Maidstone Line (2.0 miles)
Car Parking :	Parking is at Tesco Lunsford Park Supermarket, ME20 6RJ. Please park furthest from the supermarket, but not beyond the barriered section of car park which might get locked.
Registration :	At the parking location between 18:45hrs and 19.15hrs.
Courses :	Suitable for all abilities. Mass start 19.30hrs. Collect as many of the twenty controls as you can (in any order) within the maximum time allowance of 60 minutes. 1 point per control, 1 point will be deducted for each minute or part minute you are late back. A bonus of 1 point will be added for consecutive controls with the same last number (61 & 71, or 75 & 65 etc). Course closes 20.30hrs.
Equipment :	Competitors to wear light coloured clothing, or reflective tops, and have a torch. SPORTIDENT timing will be used. Please bring your dibber to registration as a punched registration system will be used for this event. If you don't have a dibber, they are available to hire from registration for £1. Lost hired dibbers will be charged at a cost of £30.
Fees :	BOF Seniors £4, Non BOF Seniors £6 (including dibber hire) and Juniors £3. Groups on a single entry appropriate senior rate + £1 per extra person.
Start :	19.30hrs. Please arrive in good time.
Facilities :	There are toilet facilities at Tesco Lunsford Park Supermarket.
Results :	Results will be available at the après-O and on the DFOK website within a few days.
