DIRECTIONS Parking is off the B2016 Seven Mile Lane, post code TN15 8QY, OS. TQ645 556 (sheet 188). From the east & west leave M26 at jct2a & take A20 towards Paddock Wood & Maidstone, turn right onto B2016 after approx. 1km. From the north leave M20 at jct2 & take A20 towards Paddock Wood & Maidstone, turn right onto B2016 after approx. 5km. From the south take A26 from Tonbridge towards Maidstone & turn left on to B2016 approx. 3.5km beyond Hadlow. The event will be signed on the B2016.

PARKING Is on firm ground adjacent to assembly area, parking fee of £1 per car.

TERRAIN. Mixed woodland, steep slopes to the south visited by Black to Green courses, muddy & brambly in places.

STARTS. There are two starts, Black to Green use the far start, 1.3km level walk from car park, Light Green to Yellow use the near start 150m from the car park, tag course is adjacent to car park.

FACILITIES Toilets, Red Cross, Squash at finish, dogs on assembly area only please, there are deer in the forest & we don't want to disturb them any more than necessary so as not to jeopardise access in the future.
